Museums are places where they show art pieces either from today's time (paintings, sculptures and others) or things that people made and used many years ago (or old times). One such museum is the Archaeological Museum of Igoumenitsa.

The archaeological museum in Igoumenitsa shows the life of people who lived in the area of Thesprotia from very old times to Byzantine times, that is from about 100,000 BC until 1,453 AD.

In the museum they show the first houses and also the towns. They give information about how people were organized in groups.



Also they show things that are about daily life either at home or in the neighborhood such as cooking tools, things for personal care and cleanliness and also different toys.



In the museum the visitors can see tools and weapons that they used for war.



A special part exists for the burial habits they followed when someone died.





The museum's website has the days and hours that the museum works.

To visit someone the museum, it is needed to have a ticket. The visitors can buy the ticket at the counter.

Inside the museum and also in its yard there are comfortable seats for visitors who need rest.
